Created by Dutch designers Alik van der Kruijs and Jos Klarenbeek, the Kadans 2.0 research project examines the potential of raw scientific data: Can detailed measurements of the motions of the North Sea be transformed into something widely accessible, such as textile?

About Organisation:

In their own ways, Alik and Jos had been compiling environmental and textile data for years before meeting each other.

In 2016, at the 10 Years Thomas Eyck group show in the Zuiderzeemuseum, where they found themselves as exhibitors, it all clicked. "We are both interested in invisible forces," they explained. "It was immediately clear that we could combine our skills and viewpoints." And there, that invisible weaving of complementary expertise marked the beginning of Kadans.
